

# Possessive Adjectives

## Règles essentielles

Talking about ownership: My, Your, His, Her.

Singular: mon/ma/mes (my), ton/ta/tes (your), son/sa/ses (his/her). Plural: notre/nos (our), votre/vos (your), leur/leurs (their).

Special rule: before a feminine noun starting with a vowel, use mon/ton/son instead of ma/ta/sa: mon amie (not ma amie).

\_\_\_ mère est gentille. (my)MaMonMesSa Mère is feminine ma.

Mère is feminine ma.

\_\_\_ amie est française. (my, f.)MonMaMesSa Before feminine vowel use mon.

Before feminine vowel use mon.

Où sont \_\_\_ clés ? (your, tu)testontavos Plural "your" (informal) = tes.

# Possessive Adjectives

## Points clés

- Possessive adjectives agree with the thing owned, not the owner.
- Masculine singular: mon, ton, son. Feminine singular: ma, ta, sa.
- Plural (both genders): mes, tes, ses. Nous/Vous: notre/nos, votre/vos.
- Before a feminine noun starting with a vowel, use mon/ton/son: mon amie.
- Son/sa/ses means BOTH "his" and "her" - the gender follows the noun, not the person.
- Before a feminine noun starting with a vowel: mon/ton/son (for smooth pronunciation). "Mon amie" NOT "ma amie."
- Notre (our) and votre (your formal) don't change for gender - only for number: notre/nos, votre/vos.
- Common mistake: "sa" doesn't mean "her." "Sa maison" = his OR her house.

## Tableaux

Français	English	Exemple
mon/ma/mes	my	Mon frère est grand.
ton/ta/tes	your (informal)	Ta maison est belle.
son/sa/ses	his/her/its	Son chat est noir.
notre/nos	our	Notre école est grande.
votre/vos	your (formal)	Vos enfants sont adorables.

## Notes

### Possessive Adjectives

Possessive adjectives show ownership. Unlike English, they agree with the thing owned, not the owner. So "his house" and "her house" are both sa maison (because maison is feminine).
